Mr. Barney Carnacle -The Ring Master played by Travis Eberhard will direct the attention to different aspects of the live and screen action.

The animated multilayered cinematic display created by Mike Daley of Cardiff University, Wales will emulate various amusement park rides such as a carousel. Virtual puppets created by Marla Schweppe and Joe Geigel of Rochester Institute of Technology, New York will perform

Beth Miklavcic has written and framed the performance structure of the *InterPlay*; and she will contribute photography and screen animations to the project. The performance will occur simultaneously in West Chicago, IL; Salt Lake City, UT, Rochester, NY and Cardiff, Wales UK over Internet 2.

InterPlay: Carnivale will premiere at the Intermountain Network and Scientific **Computation Center**

(INSCC) Auditorium on the campus of the University of Utah. Be a part of the studio audience and view the full effect of the live performances, see the full screen display and the behind the scenes filming.
